



Summer Camp Positions

Camp Director, Camp Counselor, and Fishing Camp Counselor

- **Traditional Camp** is 11 weeks and runs May 28 – August 9, Monday – Friday from 9 am to 4 pm. Typical work hours are Monday – Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, not to exceed 40 hours. Fishing Camp Counselors work 4 to 20 hours a week, Monday – Friday 9 am to 12:30 pm. No scheduled work on July 4. This is a non-paid holiday.
- **Off-Site Camps** run 6 weeks from June 10 – July 26, Monday – Friday from 9 am to 3 pm. Typical work hours are Monday – Friday from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm, not to exceed 35 hours. No off-site camps are scheduled for the week of July 1 - 5.

Requirements:

- All camp positions are required to attend Mandatory Training Week: Monday, May 20 – Friday, May 24 from 9 am to 4 pm.
- All camp positions are required to attend Mandatory Mid-Summer Training on Sunday, July 7, 2024, from 4 pm to 6 pm.
- Camp Directors are required to attend Mandatory Training Week for Camp Directors: Monday, May 13 – Friday, May 17 from 9 am to 2 pm. Must attend weekly Camp Director meetings.
- Minors must not work over 5 hours without a 30-minute non-paid break.
- If you have valid CPR/AED/First Aid or Concussion training certifications, please provide a copy with your application.
- Vacation requests must be submitted no later than Monday, May 13, 2024.
 - ✓ Camp Director: A total of 8 workdays may be requested off for traditional camps.
 - ✓ Camp Counselor: A total of 12 workdays may be requested off for traditional camps.
 - ✓ Fishing Counselor: A total of 5 total workdays may be requested off.
