

AUDITION GUIDELINES

- Audition registration is required in advance.
 - All participants in grades 2-8 interested in being cast in a production must have previously completed Acting Level One and/or Two (depending on the series' requirements) at the time of the auditions. High schoolers do not need to participate in our classes in order to audition. The grade requirements must be met as of the first day of rehearsal and grade requirements refer to the current school year.
 - All auditionees must bring a headshot or photo. Resumes are recommended but not required.
 - Auditionees must prepare a one-minute memorized monologue. For musicals, please also prepare a one-minute selection from a Broadway-style song and bring an instrumental version of the song on CD, phone or iPod. Please do not bring sheet music as an accompanist will not be provided. Singing a cappella or alongside a recorded voice is strongly discouraged. For help selecting audition material, contact the Theatre Educator at education@townhalltheatre.org.
 - Callbacks are generally scheduled on Saturdays the week following auditions.
- There is an instructional fee for children currently enrolled in grades 2-12 cast in any production at THT. The fees are not due at the time of audition but must be paid prior to the first rehearsal.
